Authority responsibility:

The Board of Directors is the legal authority for PLAN Okanagan (Okanagan Lifetime Networks Association). As a member of the Board, a Director acts in a position of trust for the community and is responsible for the effective governance of the organization.

Qualifications/Skills:

Terms:

Term is 2 years.

Requirements:

- Regular attendance at board meetings and AGM, and must acquire information from any missed meetings
- Serves on at least one committee.
- A time commitment of approximately 3-5 hours per month.

Major Duties:

- Prepare for and participate in the discussions and the deliberations of the Board

Time parameters

- Meetings are two hours in length on the second Tuesday of the month.
